You can create a permanent legacy by leaving a bequest of a specific amount, a percentage of your estate, or the remainder of your estate in your will or living trust. There is no limit on the amount you may set aside from your estate. You may make a gift as large or as small as you would like. You may choose to make a gift of cash, securities, or other property. Your estate will receive a tax deduction in the amount of your charitable bequest. If you have already drafted your will, your attorney can help you arrange a charitable bequest with a simple amendment, or codicil.

You can use the following language to create a charitable bequest in your will:

Unrestricted bequests:

*I devise and bequeath \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (or \_\_\_\_\_% of my residuary estate) to the JCC of Greater Rochester's Camp Seneca Lake, for its general purposes; 1200 Edgewood Ave., Rochester, NY 14618*

Restricted/Special purposes: Support a cause of interest to you every year, in perpetuity, with a designated bequest to establish an endowment fund:

*I devise of bequeath \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (or \_\_\_\_\_% of my residuary estate) to the JCC of Greater Rochester's Camp Seneca Lake, to be added to and administered as part of its Rerserve Funds; 1200 Edgewood Avenue, Rochester, NY 14618*

Residuary bequests: This type of bequest is made when you intend to leave the residue portion of your assets after other terms of the will have been satisfied:

*All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, I give to the JCC of Greater Rochester's Camp Seneca Lake, for its general purposes; 1200 Edgewood Avenue, Rochester, NY 14618*

Contingency bequests: The type of bequest allows you to leave a portion of your estate to the JCC of Greater Rochester's Camp Seneca Lake if your named beneficiary does not survive you:

*I devise and bequeath the residue of the property, and real and personal and wherever situated, owned by me at my death, to [name of beneficiary], if [she/he] survives me. If [name of beneficiary] does not survive me, I devise and bequeath my residuary estate to the JCC of Greater Rochester's Camp Seneca Lake, for its general purposes.*
